Spartanburg County breaks ground on \$24.6 million pet resource center

Spartanburg County officials broke ground on a new multimillion-dollar pet resource center on Thursday, December 5.

The facility, which is located near the Spartanburg Downtown Airport, costs \$24.6 million which is covered by the county as well as American Rescue Plan Act funds. It will allow the county to house and care for its animal community and end the temporary contract with Greenville County Animal Care, which took in thousands of animals from Spartanburg support rooms

County since 2011.

The federal American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding Spartanburg County received allows investment in certain areas, including the Pet Resource Spartanburg Center. County Council approved \$5,000,000 of ARP Funds be allocated to assisting in the construction of the

The single-story 26,600 sq. ft. facility will include: • Dog housing (79 ken-

- Cat housing (12 ken-
- nels) Isolation housing
- Adoption and clinic lobbies
- · Staff offices, workstations, break room, and

• Surgery, x-ray, pharmacy, and exam rooms

• Multipurpose room The site will also include 18,600 sq. ft. of exterior space (including 5,000 square feet of covered exterior areas). The exterior space will include:

- Multiple fenced animal
- Artificial turf zones
- · Temporary housing for farm animals
- 72 parking spaces

The county is continuing to hire staff for the facility, which is scheduled to open by the end of 2025. Programs will be available to help keep animals with their owners, along with medical services and an adoption center.

3. Upon information and belief. Defendant Jermerica Daniels ("Daniels") is a citizen and resident of Barnwell County, South Carolina.

4. Upon information and belief, Defendant Aaliyah Flowers is a citizen and resident of Barnwell County, South

5. This action is brought under the provisions of the South Carolina Declaratory Judgment Act and Rule 57 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure; there is a real and justiciable controversy between the parties, and by these proceedings Plaintiff asks this Court to inquire into and declare the rights and obligations of the parties arising out of the facts set forth

6. Upon information and belief, the conduct that gave rise to the Complaint occurred in Barnwell County, South Carolina, and all the Defendants are residents of Barnwell County, South Carolina. Therefore, venue is proper in Barn-

7. Upon information and belief, Heyward is the grandfather of Daniels.

8. Daniels and Heyward do not reside in the same household.

9. On April 30, 2018, Progressive Direct issued an updated automobile insurance policy, Policy Number 35025935 (the "Policy"), to Heyward. (Exh. A; Progressive Direct Policy).

10. The declarations page reflects that the Policy is effective from January 14, 2018, through July 14, 2018, and insures two vehicles including a 2006 Toyota Corolla (the "Accident Vehicle"). (Exh. 11. According to the Policy:

"Insured person" means: a. you, a relative, or a

rated resident with respect to an accident arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of an auto or a trailer;

b. any person with respect to an accident arising out of that person's use of a covered auto with the permission of

you, a relative or a rated res-

12. Daniels owns the Accident Vehicle.

13. Daniels maintains the Accident Vehicle.

14. Daniels pays for all expenses related to the Accident Vehicle, including reimbursing Heyward for the insurance premiums.

15. The Accident Vehicle is registered to Daniels.

16. The Accident Vehicle is primarily garaged at Daniels' residence.

17. Heyward derives no benefit from the Accident Vehicle and would suffer no loss from its

18. Daniels is not listed on the Policy as a relative or rated driver.

19. On May 12, 2018, Aaliyah Flowers ("Flowers") was driving the Accident Vehicle down Legion Road, approaching Solomon Blatt Avenue, with Daniels riding as a passenger. 20. Flowers then entered the intersection, failing to yield the right of way to Cody Gleaton ("Gleaton"), operating his 2019 GMC Sierra.

21. Gleaton struck the Acci- ${\tt dent\ Vehicle's\ front\ passenger}$ side quarter panel.

22. Flowers was cited as contributing to the collision.

23. On May 6, 2021, Daniels filed a lawsuit against Flowers in the Barnwell County Court of Common Pleas, Civil Action No. 2021CP0600121 (the "Underlying Action).

24. In the Underlying Action, Daniels brought a cause of action alleging negligence against Flowers. 25. The Circuit Court entered

default against Flowers on August 13, 2021, and referred the case to a Special Referee on July 12, 2022.



Clemson breaks ground on Harvey S. Peeler Jr. College of Veterinary Medicine

Clemson University officials and state leaders broke ground Friday, November 22 on the Harvey S. Peeler Jr. College of Veterinary Medicine, marking a historic moment for Clemson University and the state of South Carolina as the only college of veterinary medicine in the state continues to take shape.

Earlier Friday, Clemson's Board of Trustees approved the name of the new college, which honors Harvey S. Peeler Jr., a 1970 graduate of the University who has served as a senator in the South Carolina General

Assembly since 1980.

"Senator Peeler has passionately supported the development of a college of veterinary medicine for more than 20 years, and his efforts throughout the process have been instrumental in developing this new college at Clemson," Clemson Board Chair Kim Wilkerson said.

Peeler, chairman of the Senate Finance Committee and a cattle farmer in his hometown of Gaffney, has experienced firsthand the need for large and small animal veterinarians in the

"Today marks a historic milestone for our state as we break ground on the new College of Veterinary Medicine — a dream that's been a long time in the



making," said Peeler.

He added, "This is not iust about education — it is about taking care of our animals, supporting our farmers, growing our economy and filling the need for veterinarians in South Carolina." "The Harvey S. Peeler Jr. College of Veterinary Medicine will be an incredible asset not only for Clemson University but for the entire state of

South Carolina, our region beyond," and Clemson University President Jim Clements.

He added, "Today's historic groundbreaking is a testament to the dedication and commitment of the South Carolina General Assembly, the Clemson University Board of Trustees, faculty, staff, students and champions like Senator Harvey Peeler."

And Clements said,

"Together, we are further elevating our land-grant mission and continuing to meet the needs of our communities through education, research and service."

The complex is located across the street from University's Clemson Equine Center on West Queen Street in Pendleton.

It comprises six buildings designed to provide students with spaces for collaboration, hands-on learning and personal growth.

Officials said the College of Veterinary Medicine will help address the shortage of veterinarians in the

A third of South Carolina counties have fewer than five veterinarians, and 48 percent of the state's counties have fewer than 10 veterinarians.

While qualified candidates are applying to veterinary colleges, 500-1,000 aren't admitted due to a capacity shortage at existing colleges, the officials said.

The Harvey S. Peeler Jr. College of Veterinary Medicine continues the process of earning accreditation. It's expected to welcome its first class of 80 students in Fall 2026.

The Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree and curriculum have approved by the Board of Trustees, and the hiring of faculty and staff will continue in earnest for the next two years.

Christmas Price Index 2024 reflects wage growth and rising service prices

(StatePoint) On the first day of Christmas, holiday gift giving begins with the traditional gift of a Partridge in a Pear Tree. By the first day of January, True Love pays the bill.

Each holiday season, the PNC's Christmas Price Index tabulates the price to gift all the items in the song "The Twelve Days of Christmas," and this year, that figure amounts to \$49,263.47, a 5.4% increase from 2023.

PNC's Christmas Price Index mimics the Bureau of Labor Statistics' (BLS) Consumer Price Index, which measures the average change in prices consumers pay for goods and services over Notably higher in 2024 than the BLS' CPI, which increased 2.4% year over year, PNC's index reflects wage growth in the service industry as the primary driver of the overall higher

"Believe it or not, we're still seeing the cause and effect of the pandemicinflation hangover, even nearly five years later," says Amanda Agati, chief investment officer of PNC's Asset Management Group. "With years of steep price increases, we'd inflation nowhere to go, but we'd be wrong."

Services Over Goods

The service-based economy is represented by the last four gifts in the index the Ladies Dancing, Lords-a-Leaping, Pipers Piping and Drummers Drumming. They're traditionally priced based on the cost to hire various performers and musicians. Ten-Lords-A-Leaping, at \$14,539.20, is the highest priced gift in the index for the third straight year. Overall, the service-sector gifts rose in price by 7.9% in 2024.

This rise of service-sec-



in the U.S. economy since PNC's index launched in 1984. At that time, goods comprised 70% of the Consumer Price Index, while today that number

stands at just 35%. Many of the gifts in the index representing goods remained unchanged in price in 2024 – the Turtle Doves, Calling Birds, Gold Rings and Swans all stayed flat, though still expensive year over year. The French Hens and Geese were the avian exceptions, with the latter representing one of the most volatile gifts in this year's index, growing by more than 15%.

Housing Still High

The most volatile gift in the 2024 index is the first one – the Partridge in a Pear Tree - which rose in price by 17.1%. The least volatile gift, the Eight-Maids-a-Milking, remained unchanged since 2009.

The Christmas Price Index also calculates the "True Cost of Christmas," which is the cost of purchasing all of the gifts as they repeat in the verses of the song. That cost increased by 3.6% to

If you prefer to shop online, you'll pay nearly packaging and shipping that gifts of birds require.

PNC's online Christmas Price Index cost rose by 3.9% in 2024 to a total of \$54,073.69. Most of the

commanded an increase for internet shopping, but if you're looking for bargain buys based on last year's budget, the price of the Calling Birds, Gold Rings and Swans remained flat online in 2024.






