Byrnes teacher honored as District Five STEM Educator of the Year

The Spartanburg Science Center surprised seven educators across Spartanburg County with news that they were the district finalists for the 2024 STEM Educator of the Year Awards. Peyton Proffitt, a Project Lead the Way teacher at Byrnes High School, received the exciting news he was District Five's representative.

The awards, in their second year, celebrate the creativity, perseverance, and fortitude of our K-12 public school educators in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. Educators were nominated by peers, administrators, students and community members this past Spring, and a blind judging process took place over the summer. The seven finalists are in the running for the STEM Educator of the Year, who will be announced during a Celebration on October 21 at Chapman Cultural Center.

Proffitt, along with other recipients, received a check for \$2,500 and professional development opportunities from the Center. The countywide winner will receive an additional \$2,500.

Spartanburg One earns significant credit rating upgrade

Spartanburg School District One has received a double upgrade in its credit ratings, according to recent statements from Moody's Investors Service. The district's issuer rating has been elevated to A1 from A3, while the rating on the district's Installment Purchase Revenue Bonds (IPRBs) has improved to A2 from Baa1. This upgrade reflects the district's strong financial performance and responsible fiscal management.

Key factors influencing the upgrade include Spartanburg One's solid reserve position, increasing student enrollment, and a decreasing leverage profile. The district's available fund balance ratio has improved significantly. This financial improvement is attributed to enhanced governance and increased state and local revenues.

Moody's highlighted the district's growing enrollment and solid property tax base as key factors in the upgraded ratings. Looking ahead, Spartanburg One is committed to leveraging this positive momentum by preserving its strong financial health and advancing its mission of student-centered education.

Inman goat farmer credits Spartanburg Regional heart team with ability to return to passionate lifestyle

Debra Avent has a passion for goats. So much so that after adopting two goats as pets she began breeding them and now raises 22 goats on her hillside farm in Inman.

Enjoying the physical work of keeping her goats healthy like feeding them and providing them with fresh water, she was shocked when she could no longer walk from her home to her goat barn one day in October 2023.

She said she could not make it up the slight hill in her yard and was forced to sit down on the grass and catch her breath after feeding the animals.

"I went to the hospital, and it turns out they found a big blockage in my heart. The next day they stented me, so it was significant enough that they reacted

that quickly," said Avent, 66.

Dr. Mathew Kalapurakal was Avent's cardiologist, who had gotten her in the next day for surgery.

"They went right in through my wrist. There were no stitches, no cuts, no nothing, it was just amazing."

In 2022, 702,880 people died from heart disease, meaning one in every five deaths in the U.S. were attributed to heart disease, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Spartanburg Regional's Heart Wellness Center and cardiac rehabilitation program was the next step for Avent, who has since made a full recovery.

"Going to the Heart Wellness Center, they put heart monitors on you and monitor your heart rate the entire time you're working out. I was pushing as hard as I could because I knew I

had to listen to their process," Avent said.

Avent said the skill and knowledge of the program team put her mind at ease and helped her realize she was not alone in her health journey.

"I realized this is not me at the gym doing this for me, but it's me here letting them do it for me," Avent said. The staff knew the right level of hands-on care and education to build her up and encourage her rather than intimidate her.

"You tell yourself, 'I can't get on a bicycle and bike for 10 minutes or get on a treadmill for 10 minutes, but you can, you absolutely can,'" she said.

Avent has made a full recovery and can once again tend to her goats.

"I feel like I'm 22 again, and I'm actually 66," Avent said jokingly. "I'm so thankful."

State honors R.B. Simms and Landrum Water Treatment facilities

The Landrum and R.B. Simms Water Treatment Facilities received the South Carolina Area-Wide Optimization Excellence Award for calendar year 2023, during South Carolina Department of Environmental Services' (SCDES) annual Surface Water Treatment Meeting recently held in Columbia, SC.

"We appreciate the honor recently given to both of our drinking water treatment plants by SCDES," said Ken Tuck, Spartanburg Water's

Director of Drinking Water Services. "This recognition shows what we hope the public can see every day: our commitment at all of our facilities to provide safe drinking water that more than meets the current standards."

SCDES initiated the SC Area-Wide Optimization Program (AWOP) in 1997. AWOP is an effort to optimize the performance of existing surface water treatment facilities. The goal of the program is to optimize

particle removal and disinfection at all filtration plants to maximize public health protection through appropriate treatment techniques.

AWOP was originally focused on microbial contaminants, but has expanded to include a disinfectant byproducts component. The optimization goals of AWOP are more stringent than drinking water standards, and Spartanburg Water System (SWS) continues to consistently meet these goals.

Furman’s helping hands seek chances to contribute after Helene

Greenville - As cleanup and utility crews still work to help communities recover from the damage of Hurricane Helene, Furman University students, faculty and staff are finding ways to help people impacted by the storm.

Over the weekend of October 5-6, students helped pack toiletry kits given to utility workers who were on campus, and the Heller Service Corps met Monday, October 7 to discuss relief efforts they may pursue, said Jason Cassidy, assistant vice president for Student Life and dean of students.

“We want to make sure that we provide impactful and intentional aid, so we are looking at the best way to make that happen,” said Meredith Carr, assistant director of the Trone Student Center, orientation and Heller Service Corps.

The Paladins rallied the Furman family to donate supplies for those affected

by Hurricane Helene, collecting items needed including toiletries, non-perishable foods, bottled water, flashlights, batteries, diapers and baby food.

Cayleigh Heaberlin '28 and Alex Cimo '28 were among the students helping pack toiletry kits over the weekend. Heaberlin said they were looking for other ways to help when a friend told them about

efforts to distribute food and supplies in the Berea community, near campus. They and other Furman students helped volunteers Monday at Neighborhood Focus hand out plates of

food, provided by FEMA and other donors.

“I’m from up north, and I didn’t know how impactful a hurricane could be,” Cimo said. “Just being here volunteering at

Neighborhood Focus, you hear about so many people still having issues with power.”

Neighborhood Focus played host to other organizations, including the American Red Cross and LiveWell along with volunteers from the United Way, local schools and other community organizations. Holly Roberts, owner of The Codfather Nexton, a fish and chips restaurant in Summerville, South Carolina, near Charleston, brought enough food to provide about 600 meals for families that came to receive aid.

José Morales-Martinez, a social worker at nearby Berea High School, said Monday’s efforts to provide for local families still living without power grew quickly as volunteers and donors seized the opportunity to help. There’s no manual on how to handle providing aid after a disaster, he said, but it was encouraging to see the number of people looking for ways to serve.

Brazilian soccer legend Ronaldinho joins ownership group of Greenville Triumph and Liberty
