Oshkosh Defense recently announced the addition of a wildlife preserve at its Spartanburg Assembly facility where Oshkosh will build the Next Generation Delivery Vehicle (NGDV). This initiative is a testament to Oshkosh's commitment to sustainability and environmental stewardship.

"Our intent is to turn our greenspace at the facility into a thriving habitat for native wildlife, supporting biodiversity, and a healthy ecosystem," said Trent McJunkin, facilities and maintenance manager at Oshkosh Defense Spartanburg Assembly. "This effort not only helps wildlife flourish, but also increases efficiencies in groundskeeping, demonstrating that sustainability and operational effective-

ness can go hand in hand." Oshkosh partnered with Hatcher Garden and Woodland Preserve; a public garden and not-for-profit organization based in Spartanburg that serves as a sanctuary for native plants. Dan Shook, Hatcher Garden Manager shares, "Hatcher Garden is thankful to partner with the Oshkosh Defense Spartanburg Assembly Plant to begin this transition from the traditional mowed turf with constant chemical input, to a designed natural space for living animals and insects that can bring together people and nature in a way that creates interest and adds value to our lives."

In addition to partnering with Hatcher Garden, Oshkosh also worked with the Wildlife and Industry Together (WAIT) program. WAIT, a program of the South Carolina Wildlife Federation (SCWF),

assists corporate landowners in integrating wildlife habitat needs into corporate land management decisions. "One of the greatest drivers of biodiversity loss is land degradation and habitat loss," said Jay Keck, SCWF industry habitat manager. "When a property owner like Oshkosh Defense restores wildlife habitat through the installation of native plants and nest boxes, it supports the local ecosystem by allowing it to perform its natural functions, which in turn supports a huge diversity of plant and animal species."

The addition of the wildlife preserve serves as a testament to what can be achieved when communities unite. Oshkosh Defense is proud to be a part of the Spartanburg community and hopes this initiative inspires other organizations in the area to follow suit.

Fall 2024 brings record enrollment to SMC

For the first time in history, Spartanburg Methodist College welcomed more than 1,100 students for the fall 2024 semester, breaking the all-time enrollment record.

The College officially announced a fall enrollment of 1,128 students, breaking the previous record of 1,072 set in 2022, and increasing 9 percent over 2023.

"It's truly rewarding to see the continued growth here at SMC," said President Scott Cochran. "Bringing in record enrollment shows that we continue to provide the academic and life experiences that students want, along with the professional development and workplace skills they need. The faculty and staff do a tremendous job ensuring SMC is a welcoming environment for our students."

Of the 1,128 students, 933 are attending on-campus and 195 are enrolled in SMC Online, also a record. The College also set a record for the number of new incoming students at 601.

SMC continues to grow its academic program, to which school officials attribute some of the growth. With several new bachelor's degree options added in the past couple of years, the college provides a broader appeal to students seeking a specific academic program.

"We've been very deliberate in selecting our new degree programs, which has been beneficial in attracting new students," said Dr. Curt Laird, provost and executive vice president for academic affairs. "The growth of the SMC Online program provides another opportunity for us to serve an audience that may not otherwise be able to pursue their college degree."

The College has approximately 490 students living on campus. There are just over 270 student-athletes enrolled for SMC's first year participating in four-year sports in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA).

The fall semester got off to a grand start with this year's annual move-in day for first-time students. Faculty, staff, and student volunteers helped more than 260 new students move into their residence halls on August 10.

Dr. Dalicia Raymond welcomed all new students with an inspiring message at this year's Convocation on August 12.
