Converse student achieves milestone as Spartanburg's first Re:Degree graduate

This August, Converse University achieved a new milestone: recognizing student Kimberly Anderson as the first graduate from OneSpartanburg Inc.'s Re: Degree Initiative. This is a testament to the University's unwavering commitment to empowering students with the confidence to pursue their goals boldly.

OneSpartanburg Inc.'s Re:Degree program is part of Movement 2030, a strategic plan for Spartanburg County to advance economic mobility and educational attainment. The program supports the re-enrollment and degree completion of the nearly 51,000 adults across Spartanburg County. It aids local citizens with little college experience, no matter the degree level, but who did not graduate. The program offers flexible scheduling, personalized academic advising, and financial aid options to ensure that every student can achieve their educational goals.

Like many, Kimberly's educational journey had its twists and turns. She started years ago, but life took her on a different path. "Growing up on the east Spartanburg, side of Converse University has always been a staple," Kimberly shared. "I've had relatives and friends attend Converse. It's always been known for its education programs. A few years ago, when I decided to pursue Early Childhood Education, Converse was my only choice due to its reputation and location. I excelled in my courses, got to the second benchmark, and had to take the Core Praxis. Reading and writing was a breeze, but math stopped my dream."

"Dr Suzanne Gunter, Converse's Chair of the Department of Art, Design, & Letters, recommended that I complete my degree in Studio Art because I had a good art background. The plan was to begin teaching and go through PACE to get certi-

The Spartanburg Sanitary Sewer District (SSSD) is celebrating another year as the recipient of nine National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA) Peak Performance Awards for its wastewater treatment facilities.

The awards are based on 2023 performance, and reflect ongoing compliance with permits related to the discharge and disposal of pollutants.

Platinum Awards are given to facilities that meet full compliance with permits over a consecutive five-year period. When 100 percent compliance is maintained beyond the initial award, Platinum Award status continues, noted by the number of years. Spartanburg City Council approves agreement for Florida Avenue townhome development

Spartanburg City Council unanimously approved a development agreement at their meeting on August 26 that paves the way for a new 95-unit townhome development near the city's northern boundary.

Located along Florida Ave., near Spartanburg Medical Center, the \$23 million development will have ten of its units set aside for tenants at or below 80 percent of area median income as part of the development agreement. Units will average 1,550 square feet and will feature three bedrooms and two baths. The development will also feature around 2,000 square feet of commercial space, with a restaurant concept expected to occupy that space.

Under terms of the agreement, some portions of the development cur-

rently outside city limits will be annexed, and the City will maintain public improvements related to the development. The agreement also includes a fee-in-lieu of tax payment plan. According to the City Manager, the development will generate annual local government revenues of over \$250,000 in the first year of the agreement and will step up to over \$600,000 in year 10.

Around South Carolina

Cargo volumes up 8% at Port of Charleston, up 17% at Inland Port Greer

Charleston, SC - Highly productive port operations and a strategic location in the thriving Southeast is driving cargo growth at South Carolina Ports.

SC Ports had an 8% uptick in container volumes in July compared to the year prior. The start of peak season and a growing population in the region boosted loaded imports by

"The South Carolina market is ripe for companies to put new investment in the ground and benefit from direct access to our world-class port system," SC Ports President and CEO Barbara Melvin said. "We deliver reliable port service, a strong intermodal network and future capacity to support growth."

SC Ports and our broader community maritime worked together to efficiently move 224,407 TEUs and 124,448 pier containers filled with goods at the Port of Charleston last month. This

marked the second highest record spurred by the pan-July ever for SC Ports, second only to the July 2021

demic-related import

Both rail-served inland ports continued to have stellar cargo growth, han-

dling a combined 21,013 rail moves in July, which is up 19% from last year.

Inland Port Greer had an all-time record July, moving 17,332 containers on and off trains, a 17% increase year-over-year.

Inland Port Dillon also set a record in July, with 3,681 rail moves, which is up 26% from last year.

SC Ports handled 10,814 vehicles in July, which is down year-over-year as July is typically a slower month for this segment. SC Ports supports global automakers' supply chains by importing parts and exporting finished vehicles for BMW Manufacturing Co., Mercedes-Benz Vans and Volvo Cars, among others.

"The team at South Carolina Ports works in tandem with many maritime and logistics partners every day to efficiently move goods in support of our customers," Melvin said. "It takes all of us working together to keep the supply chain fluid for the U.S. East Coast port





